Subject: SDS/GHS compliance or Letter of exemption pertaining thereto

To Whom It May Concern:

OSHA 1910.1200 has been updated to align with the UN Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS), Revision 3, issued in the Federal Register, March 26, 2012. This rule became effective May 25, 2012.

Pursuant to OSHA regulation 1910.1200 (c) aligned with the requirements of the Global Harmonized system (GHS), the product in question is classified as an “article”. The product does not release or emit hazardous substances and exposure does not present a health problem under normal conditions of work.

An “article” means a manufactured item: Which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture which has end use functions dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use; and which does not release, or otherwise result in exposure to, a hazardous chemical under normal conditions of use. Any product which meets the definition of an “article” would be exempt from the requirements of the Standard.

Therefore, we have been advised by OSHA officials that this letter should suffice in lieu of a Safety Data Sheet (SDS).
